## Congressional act is good for community, America

Ideally, every one of us wants a government and Congress that can work collaboratively to pass laws that improve our quality of life. This common-sense approach to government was in action last week when the U.S. Senate did just that by passing S.2155, the Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief and Consumer Protection Act.

More than 60 U.S. senators (51 Republicans, 16 Democrats and one Independent) came together, compromised and produced legislation that will make an important, positive change in all our lives.

S. 2155 eases, but does not eliminate, some regulatory burdens for credit unions and other community-based lenders from the 2010 Dodd-Frank law.

Dodd-Frank has made it difficult for smaller lenders to provide affordable loans, offer quality savings programs and reinvest in our communities.

The bill has made its way into the House of Representatives. If the House follows the bipartisan example of the Senate, the bill, and its provisions to help America, will be on its way to the president for his signature.

We ask that Rep. Liz Cheney vote in support of S. 2155. It will protect seniors from elder abuse, make mortgage processing easier and quicker, increase affordable rental housing in our communities, and allow credit unions and other community-based lenders to provide better service to members.

This is good for our entire community and America.
